What's in My Kitchen?



The home appliance industry is a multibillion dollar industry. With the rise in popularity of new kitchen appliances, Mason County's FCS Extension agent partnered with Bracken County's FCS Extension agent and two Mason County Extension Homemaker Volunteers to develop a new program called What's In My Kitchen? for the residents of Mason County. The purpose of the program was to offer information on new and popular kitchen appliances, current trends, and to help participants make informed decisions about future appliance purchases. Appliances covered were slow cookers, air fryers, dehydrators, bread machines, electronic programmable pressure cookers, and cast iron cookware. Participants said they learned more about the appliances than they could have learned from reading the boxes in the stores.
