SPOTLIGHT: OWSLEY COUNTY

Tackling Your Laundry



Every 45 minutes, a poison control center in the U.S. receives a call about a child who has been exposed to laundry detergent chemicals. The Lee and Owsley counties FCS Extension agents travelled to eight counties to present Tackling Your Laundry. During the program, KEHA leaders discussed ways to create a safe laundry room to protect your families, matched laundry products to the right jobs, identified ways to remove common stains that tend to ruin garments, and differentiated between traditional and highefficiency washing machines. Participants indicated that they had made changes to their laundry areas such as storing laundry products in a safe location, that they now wash their laundry on appropriate cycles and at the correct temperature to extend the wear of garments, and that they understand garment labels better and read them prior to laundering.
