SPOTLIGHT: CARROLL COUNTY

SuperStar Chef



The obesity rate in the state of Kentucky is in the top 3% for our nation. In Carroll County, the obesity rate for high school students is 20.2%. When they are in the SuperStar Chef program, participants learn how to prepare healthier foods, learn why they should decrease their intake of sugary drinks, increase their activity level, and learn to plan healthy meals. After participating in the SuperStar Chef program, all respondents (100%) reported that they can identify healthy foods, and that they plan to drink more water every day, drink less soda, be more physically active, eat more fruits, and eat more vegetables.
