SPOTLIGHT: ROCKCASTLE COUNTY

Cook Together, Eat Together



During the spring and fall of 2019, the Rockcastle County Family and Consumer Sciences Extension agent offered the Cook Together, Eat Together program. The FCS agent led the food preparation sessions and taught youths the basic skills in the program. Each session had six dinner socials. Youth participants earned their cookbooks by attending at least three of the six program sessions offered. After the program, 75% of the youths reported eating more healthy meals, and 90% reported that they had tried a new food. One parent reported that her child had always refused to try eggs; during the session on breakfast, the child tried and liked frittatas.
