SPOTLIGHT: WOODFORD COUNTY

Field to Fork: Workshop and agent training



Preparing and cooking wild game is an important skill that hunters need to know. More importantly, they must understand food safety as it relates to wild game. The Woodford County Family and Consumer Sciences Extension agent in partnership with the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources offered a two-day workshop to educate hunters on laws and regulations, hunting tactics and safety, proper wild game butchering, meat handling safety, freezing, jerky-making, and home-canning. The workshop involved new hunters learning all about the sport, including practicing shooting on a target range, working with a mentor experienced hunter to deer hunt, a butchering demonstration on the safety and best practices of home processing a deer. In addition to the public program, a workshop was offered for Extension Agents to implement in their counties.
