Mix it up!

Choose different types of activities for your weekly routine, such as a fitness class, gardening, taking a walk, or trying a new workout routine.

Warm up:

Start with these moves to get your body ready.

- Standing Arm Circles – 30 seconds
- Marching in Place – 1 minute
- Air Squats – 30 seconds
- Jumping Jacks – 1 minute

Workout:

Complete the following moves, resting as needed. Repeat the circuit as many times as you can, with the correct form.

- Knee Pushups - 15 reps
- Standing Lunges - 15 each leg
- Bicycle Crunches - 30 seconds
- Knee Pushups - 15 reps
- Standing Lunges - 15 each leg
- Bicycle Crunches - 30 seconds
